

A Brighter Future: How Solar Energy Empowers More Than 60 Indigenous Communities in Latin America

Over 3,500 Indigenous people gain access to solar energy, improving their health and opportunities, while addressing decades of marginalization and environmental harm.

For generations, Indigenous communities across Latin America have faced the dual burden of environmental devastation from extractive industries and a lack of basic services like affordable, reliable energy. From poisoned waterways due to oil drilling in the Amazon to displacement caused by hydroelectric dams, these communities have experienced systemic neglect and exploitation, while being excluded from the benefits of energy development.

In response, an initiative has enabled clean, sustainable, and independent solar energy for more than 60 Indigenous rainforest communities in Costa Rica, Colombia, Panama, Peru and Ecuador over the past decade. Today, more than 3,500 people have access to off-grid energy solutions that empower them to reclaim control over their lives and lands.

This effort goes beyond providing electricity—it is a commitment to justice, resilience, and self-determination, empowering communities to build brighter, more regenerative futures.

What We Do to Create Energy Sovereignty

Lighting Up Remote Communities with Tailored Off-Grid Solar Home Systems

Each system is designed to meet the specific needs of last-mile Indigenous communities. By covering 100% of their energy needs, these off-grid solutions reduce reliance on fossil fuels and empower families with clean, safe, and reliable electricity.

Training Indigenous Technicians for Long-Term Impact

With 55 Indigenous solar technicians and trainers already trained, this initiative builds local expertise to install and maintain solar systems, ensuring communities remain self-reliant and resilient for years to come.

Creating Community-Driven Solar Infrastructure

Dedicated training and storage spaces equip communities with the tools and knowledge to sustain their clean energy transition and expand their impact at a regional level.

Impact Highlights: A Brighter Future for Generations

Energy Sovereignty and Economic Empowerment

- Solar energy reduces reliance on exploitative agreements with extractive industries, giving families control over their resources.
- Electricity supports income-generating activities like artisanal crafts and regenerative farming, aligned with cultural and community values.

Healthier Homes, Healthier Lives

- Clean energy eliminates harmful indoor air pollution from kerosene lamps and diesel generators, improving respiratory health.
- Families can now refrigerate medicines and food, enhancing nutrition and health outcomes.
- Night births can now be accompanied with light and increasing the life expectancy of both mother and child.

Educating the Next Generation

- With light available after dark, children can study, complete homework, and pursue greater educational opportunities.
- Access to electronic devices enhances learning and opens doors to future careers.

“When your child needs light to do their homework at night and the only option is a gas-powered generator, what else can you do? Here in Mañoko, we had to sell bush meat that was meant to feed our families in order to buy gasoline.”

Empowering Women and Challenging Gender Inequalities

- Electricity reduces the time women spend on domestic chores, allowing them to pursue education, leadership roles, and income-generating activities.
- Healthier, better-lit homes create safer and more comfortable environments for women and children.

Preserving Culture and Protecting Lands

- Solar-powered tools enable communities to protect their territories with GPS devices, drones, and cameras for land patrols.
- Light and electricity allow the creation of traditional handicrafts that preserve cultural heritage while boosting incomes.

Empowering Communication and Connection

- Solar power enables the charging of radios and communication equipment for remote communities to stay connected, especially in emergency situations.
- Communities can now share up-to-date information, ensuring they remain safe and informed.

Addressing Historical Injustice Through Clean Energy

The initiative's work addresses decades of environmental harm and social injustice caused by extractive industries that have exploited Indigenous lands without regard for their rights, cultures, and well-being. Indigenous Nations like the Emberá in Panama, and the Secoya in the Amazon rainforest of Ecuador have been vulnerated by displacement and the degradation of their lands, leaving lasting scars and an ongoing struggle for their physical and cultural survival.

This solar energy program represents a transformative shift, restoring dignity and self-determination by creating decentralized, community-driven energy solutions. Power to create hopeful alternatives and economic opportunities that are in harmony with the Indigenous people's way of life and the protection of their ancestral homeland.

With over ten years of proven success, the program aims to extend its reach to more families and communities across Latin America. By creating energy sovereignty, it continues to challenge systemic inequities and create direct access to clean, safe and independent energy for those who need it most.
